

RESPONSIBILITIES OF CLUBS

Association Manual 3.2

The aim of the OANSW is to promote and develop orienteering as a sport and recreational activity, particularly in the state of NSW.

This aim is achieved by giving direction to the clubs affiliated to the OANSW. In order to seek affiliation, prospective clubs must undertake a responsibility to promote and develop orienteering and they should be of a size which will encourage membership.

Therefore, existing clubs and clubs seeking affiliation must accept the following responsibilities:

- 1 To promote and develop orienteering, preferably within a geographic area or within a special interest group in the community.
- 2 To maintain membership of the club through renewal of existing memberships and recruitment of new members
- 3 To undertake to organise at least one Major orienteering event (State League or equivalent) each two calendar years.
- 4 To undertake to produce an orienteering map of an area approved by the OANSW, not less frequently than every 3 years.
- 5 To provide the information to the OANSW as listed in Association Manual 1.5.
- 6 To be properly constituted.

The Board of OANSW may give dispensation in relation to 3 and 4 in relation to newly formed clubs.
