NSW Junior Development Squad and NSW Schools Team Code of Behaviour

Preamble

Squad and Team members are selected on the basis of the high standard of their orienteering. It is expected that this will possibly lead to their representing NSW in National competitions and the potential to represent Australia. Therefore, Squad and Team members have the right to expect high quality training arranged by the Squad and Team management and financial support from the Association (depending on the availability of Association funds).

Should Squad or Team members feel that their rights have not been given due regard, they may refer complaints to the Squad or Team management or the Association.

Code of Behaviour

The Association requires agreement to maintain a high standard of behaviour and attitude as outlined below and will require that this be confirmed each year by potential Squad and Team members before their membership of the Squad or Team is determined.

Continued membership of the Squad or Team is dependent upon members:

- 1 competing regularly in orienteering events
- 2 attending training sessions when required
- 3 engaging wholeheartedly in training
- 4 respecting each other (no abuse or singling out of individuals)
- 5 respecting their coaches and management
- 6 caring for Association property
- 7 caring for public property
- 8 engaging in appropriate social behaviour (no skylarking or risk taking)
- 9 behaving quietly and sensibly out of respect for the rights of others, especially the general public.

I have read the above Code of Behaviour for the NSW Junior Development Squad and NSW Schools Team and agree to abide by it. I understand that a breach could lead to my removal from the Squad or Team.
